Lucian Michael Freud, OM CH (, 8 December 1922 – 20 July 2011) was a British painter and draughtsman, specialising in figurative art, and is known as one of the foremost 20th-century portraitists. He was born in Berlin, the son of Jewish architect Ernst L. Freud and the grandson of Sigmund Freud. Freud got his first name "Lucian" from his mother in memory of the ancient writer Lucian of Samosata.

Recognised as one of the leading 20th-century portraitists, Lucian Freud (1922–2011) was a British painter celebrated for his figurative paintings. His early career as a painter was influenced by surrealism, but by the early 1950s his often stark paintings tended towards realism. Freud was an intensely private man and the subjects in paintings are often the closest people in his life including his friends, family, fellow painters, lovers and children.

Artwork page for "Naked Portrait ", Lucian Freud, 1972–3 Freud is famous for his supposedly objective images of people, particularly naked women. Here the figure is shown lying awkwardly on a bed, with nothing else visible except the stool. It is as if she is an animal on the dissecting table.

Freud selected the present frame which had already been fitted with acrylic glazing at the time of Tate accession in 1990. The painting was in good condition at this time and needed no direct treatment other than improvements to its security in the frame.
